- ▶ Death of one twin in MCDA pregnancy Knowledge Source is GTG "Management of Monochorionic twin pregnancies Single twin demise page 28"
- ▶ Unilateral cleft lip & palate Follow the template of a mild anomaly
- ▶ Diaphragmatic hernia Follow the template of a serious anomaly
- ▶ Anencephaly Follow the template of a lethal anomaly.

Note:

- Each active candidate please fully prepare the 3 assigned cases as a minimum. You can also prepare the rest of cases to compare your answer to what will be discussed in class.
- -One to two cases will be chosen to present.
- -Listeners also prepare cases as to compare your preparation with what will be discussed in the class.
- -For each topic you prepare, after going through the prep videos and PDF template on "my hub",
 - 1- Quickly brush through the guideline to refresh your clinical knowledge which should take no longer than 30 minutes.
 - 2- Then read the information leaflet which you can find with the material or on (google-RCOG, NHS). The leaflet will contain the information you give to the patient in lay language. Some leaflets have different information than the guidelines. If that's the case, stick to the guideline information and use the leaflet only for the lay terminology.
 - 3- Search the part3 google drive shared on the group for similar topics. You can find cases, videos or both.
 - 4- Have your counseling written down in points for you to present.
